Sponsorship for our 2017 Zetron 'Shoot for the Stars' Golf Tournament

The Zetron golf tournament on August 22, 2017, was a great success in helping to raise funds for the Behind the Badge Foundation, a non-profit organization. The contribution from the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions Fund, helped to underwrite the costs to host the tournament and increase the net profit to help our Foundation and its programs. The event had 150 golfers. The net funds raised will be approximately \$27,000, which included your contribution.

Behind the Badge Foundation provides comprehensive support to Washington State's law enforcement agencies, family and communities after a line of duty death or when officers receive catastrophic injuries. We serve over 300 surviving family members a year, with the number increasing each time an officer is killed or seriously injured in the line of duty. Families of fallen officers include spouses/significant others, children, parents, siblings, and more, along with the law enforcement agency the officer was employed with.

Your contribution helps to fund the response of our volunteer Line of Duty Death Response Team (LODDRT) following the tragic death(s) or serious injury of an officer, immediate and ongoing support to the affected law enforcement agency and the surviving family.

Next year's Zetron 'Shoot for the Stars' Golf Tournament is scheduled for August 21, 2018 and half of the teams of golfers are already filled up. We hope that you will join us for next year's event.
