In 2017, the Adopt a Stream Foundation was awarded \$2,000 dollars by Tulalip Charitable Contributions (Q2\_2017\_14.2). This money was used improve water quality and enhance salmon habitat in Hayho Creek which is a tributary to Quilceda Creek by planting trees with volunteers.

On April 5<sup>th</sup>, 2018, AASF with the help of volunteers planted 50 red osier dogwood live stakes, 200 cottonwood live stakes, 100 willow live stakes, 25 2 gallon Spiraea, 12 5 gallon spruce, and 13 5 gallon Douglas fir. We recruited 4 adult volunteers and 10 youth volunteers for this event. The trees were purchased with funding through an ALEA grant and the Tulalip Charitable Contributions funding paid for staff time to conduct the volunteer event, prep the site April 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>, and wrap up work on April 9<sup>th</sup> 2018. Preparatory work on April 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> was also funded in part by the Tulalip Charitable Contribution grant.
