## After-School All-Stars Puget Sound

2018-2019 Final Report | Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund

ASAS Puget Sound was grateful to have received continued funding from Tulalip Tribes last year. We are delighted to share our progress and highlights! In March 2019, we expanded our programs to a third school site: Showalter Middle School in Tukwila. We are very excited to be working with one of the most diverse school districts in the nation. Along with our other two program sites (Meeker Middle School in Kent/Renton and Dimmitt Middle School in Skyway), we served 600 students in grades 6-8 during the 2018-19 school year.

ASAS provided a variety of after-school academic, enrichment, and wellness programs including dance, yoga, outdoor education, cooking and nutrition, career exploration, photography, coding and game design, and more. Students also participated in several field trips:

- Seattle Sports Commission Women's Leadership Breakfast (Fall 2018): A group of our girls attended and shared a table with Seattle Storm to pick their brains about professional opportunities in the sports industry.
- ★ T-Mobile Tech Experience Center (Winter 2018): Students learned about the future of innovation at T-Mobile, from augmented reality to parking garage sensors. They also learned about drones and experimented with virtual reality games.
- KEXP (Spring 2019): Students from our DJ & Music Production program took a career exploration field trip to the KEXP radio station in Seattle, where they learned about different jobs at the radio station, met the audio/sound engineer and DJ Chilly, toured the music library, and visited the "Live Room" where bands play live.

According to our participant surveys, students also reported the following improvements:

- \* 88% reported high levels of academic self-efficacy and school value
- \* 85% reported confidence in their goal orientation
- ★ 85% identified multiple traits they like about ASAS staff—including patience, sense of humor, and helpfulness with homework
- ★ 76% reported having a strong sense of community
- ★ 74% reported high levels of confidence in their ability to seek information and make decisions about possible careers
- ★ 72% reported high interest in STEM careers
- \* 68% reported strong leadership identity
- ★ 66% of youth cited if it weren't for ASAS, they would be bored and/or home alone
- 65% reported having a positive attitude towards healthy foods
- ★ Students experienced a 35% increase in daily physical activity on average
