The donations we received from organizations like yours allowed us to complete the project within budget.

Andy Hall of Botesch, Nash & Hall Architects, P.S. designed the display case and additional shelves. W.W. Wells Millwork constructed the case and shelves. Glass By Lund installed the glass for the case and shelves. Master Electric Company installed the lighting and electrical work for the case and shelves. All the work was completed in late July 2022.

The number of recipients impacted by our organization is as follows:

- 300 attendees – Snohomish County Sports Hall of Fame Banquet
 - The banquet is held annually in September each year.
- 39,429 spectators – 2021 events at Angel Of The Winds Arena
 - The Angel Of The Winds Arena has had many events including the Seattle Storm WNBS games over the last five months. Spectators of the Angel Of The Winds Arena events have the opportunity to view the Sports Hall of Fame display cases.
 - Angel Of The Winds Arena’s forecasted attendance for all of 2021 is 272,500. Majority of the attendance will have the opportunity to view the display cases.
- 62,095 (as of August 31, 2021) visitors – Snohomish County Sports Commission
 - The Snohomish County Sports Commission works to bring sports events to Snohomish County. In 2019, our organization had 138,661 visitors come to Snohomish County.

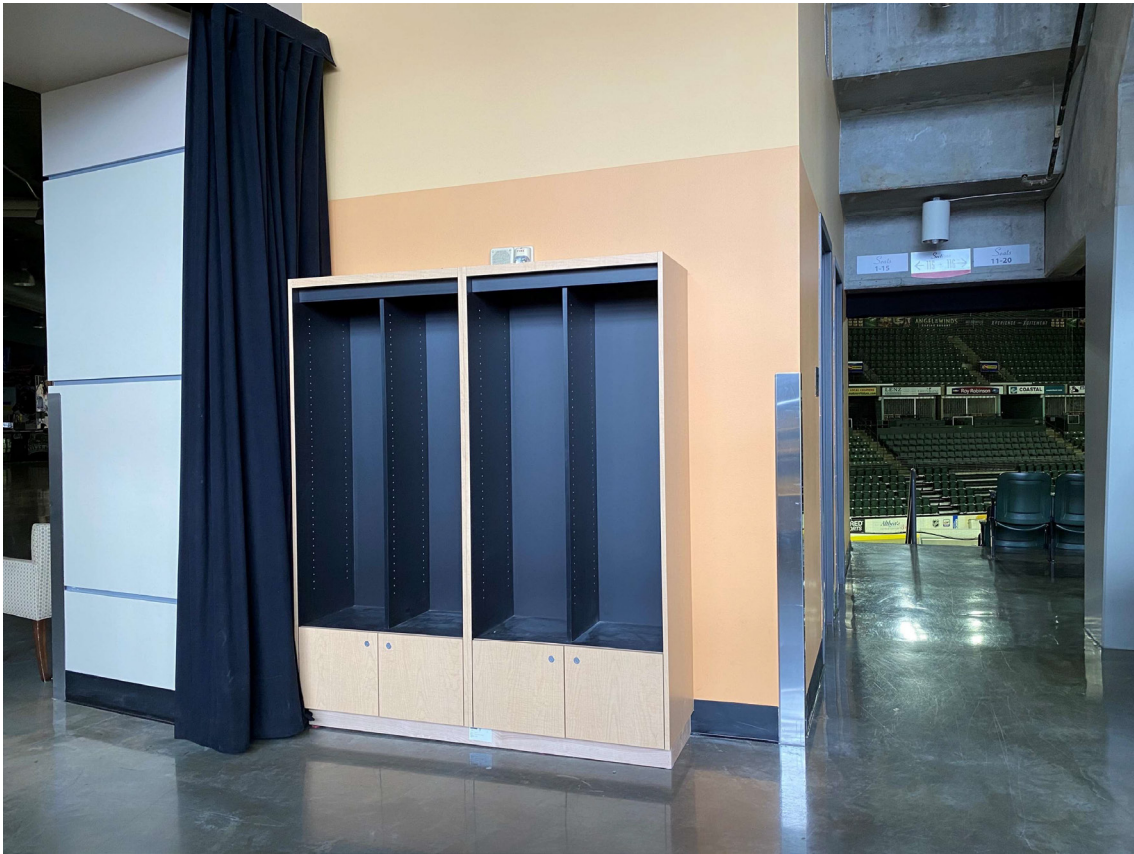
