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Tulalip Cares FY21 Q4: Grant Report

This report is written to express ArtsEd Washington's gratitude for support from the Tulalip Cares fund during our 2021-2022 fiscal year. Your Quarter 4, 2021 gift of [REDACTED] was instrumental in allowing our organization to weather challenges and emerge from the pandemic while serving the needs of students, educators, and families in our communities.

In our proposal for the 2021-22 fiscal year, we explained that your support would help us secure a new Executive Director, whose work would in turn impact several major, new projects. With your gift, we were able to fully staff this position. We were ultimately able to undertake the following projects and programs:

1) Arts 4 All Coalition: We had a successful start in the new collective impact partnership called Arts for All (A4A). The coalition set priorities, including securing a data collection specialist firm to collect and assess arts education access and participation data from every K-12 public school in the state. We will be using this data to identify gaps in arts education access and in making recommendations for ways to close those gaps. Another priority set by this coalition is the development of regional youth and educator leadership groups.

Arts for All (A4A) is a statewide coalition working to ensure high quality arts education for all PreK-12 students.

Arts Ed Washington, the Creative Advantage, Inspire Washington, Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction (OSPI), and Washington State Arts Commission (ArtsWA) are joining forces to lead statewide efforts advancing equity and access for all regions, districts and schools in Washington.

Our Regional Leaders (Spokane Arts, Tieton Arts & Humanities, Vancouver Public Schools, and Arts Corps) work with A4A to direct resources to their regional organizations and schools, as well as providing a direct flow of communication from educators on the ground throughout WA.

A4A Activities include:

- Developing arts education research
- Supporting educators and teaching artists
- Training the next generation of arts leaders
- Ensuring a vibrant and creative future for ALL students in Washington

2) Stay Inside the Lines Seattle: In 2020, ArtsEd Washington collaborated with a local Seattle artist Galen Driver to publish Stay Inside the Lines Seattle, a coloring book that featured the work of local artists, and the proceeds established a support network for arts programs in underserved King County-area schools. This network was sustained through the 2021-2022 school year; by the closing of the 2022 school year, this program served 2,279 people by providing arts supplies to schools, including three middle schools whose digital media arts programs were revived by this project.

3) School Board Surveys and PSA: Every other year, ArtsEd Washington surveys school board candidates on their perspectives, experiences, and plans for arts education. We then share the survey results in an interactive map on our website. In 2021, we partnered with On Purpose Recordings in Tacoma to create a PSA about the importance of and role of local school boards. As a result, we collected an all-time high of 449 respondents to our survey.
