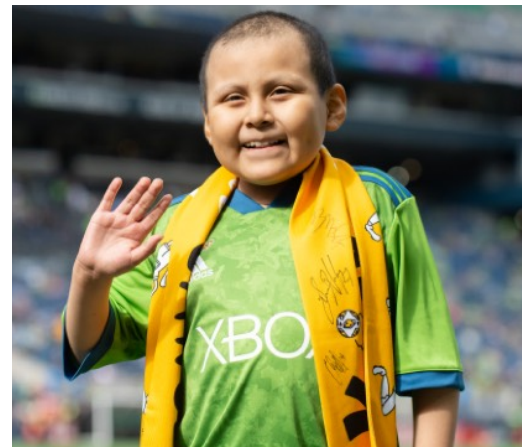

Seattle Sounders FC 2018

- 26 home matches with AEF Dream Team Captains leading the team onto the pitch.
- 20 AEF kids, and their families, attended a special #KickChildhoodCancer practice.
- More than 30 kids, and their families, marched on field at the Seattle Sounders FC #KickChildhoodCancer Match.
- #KickChildhoodCancer Honorary Team Captain Emmanuel led the team onto the pitch and flipped the coin for the captain's to start the game.
- Game tickets and suites provided to AEF families throughout the season.
