Thank you so much for your renewed support of Bridgeways with your recent \$ [REDACTED] grant in support of our Mental Health Alternatives Program (MAP) Court Liaison position.

With this tremendous gift, the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund is now a partner in providing the MAP Liaison to the collaborative, problem-solving therapeutic MAP courts at Marysville and Everett Municipal courts. Our MAP Liaison connects defendants with mental health treatment and other vital services, encourages high engagement and follow-through at each phase of the MAP program, and addresses underlying issues that contributed to past conduct.

Defendants referred to the MAP program commit to a minimum term of twelve months, which may be extended as a sanction or as otherwise appropriate. Participants earn dismissal of their charges upon successful completion of the program.

As we shared with you previously, MAP has generated some impressive impact, including a 93% reduction of recidivism among program graduates. Additional positive outcomes include increased stability through connection to resources, resolution of misdemeanor criminal charges, increased self-esteem, sense of accomplishment, self-sufficiency, positive relationships, confidence, and purpose.
