Dear Tulalip Cares,

Each month Cascade Women's Health sees hundreds of families in the Baby Boutique. This room is filled with adorable baby clothes, diapers, wipes, maternity clothes, and gear. Our incentive learning opportunities make it possible for parents to continuously earn points which they exchange for baby supplies.

Whether parents are watching pre-recorded parenting lessons online, engaging in Men's Services, attending support group or childbirth series, families are rewarded for their efforts with new and gently used items in the Boutique.

While we offer multiple opportunities to earn these supplies, many folks in our community are unable to take advantage of our incentive learning program. Barriers such as language, transportation and mental health can limit engagement.

In the spirit of being a valuable resource to more families in our community, we offer these families a monthly opportunity to exchange the items that their children no longer need for diapers and gear. We call it *Exchange Week*.

Exchange Week is typically our busiest week of the month. We are so thankful that we can be such a valuable resource to our community! In 2024 we had over 1,200 boutique visits, giving away over 37 thousand diapers, 934 packs of wipes, and 9055 clothing items!

Your partnership with Cascade Women's Health makes the Boutique a thriving resource feature of the clinic and a blessing for at-risk families in our community.

The following pages are photos of men who took part in education resources and were rewarded with car seats. The car seats were purchased by the clinic with funds from Tulalip Cares.
