Thank you for the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions' generous grant of [REDACTED] to support the Governors' Cup Golf Tournament [REDACTED] and the Chateau Ste. Michelle Scholarship Reception and Concert [REDACTED] in 2018. The Governors' Cup raised over \$360,000 to provide four-year college scholarships for alumni of Washington State's foster care system. The Chateau Ste. Michelle concert event raised over \$230,000 for scholarships for low-income, underserved youth, many of whom are children of agricultural workers. Thanks to your support, 44 new students will receive scholarships starting this fall.

Chateau Ste. Michelle Scholarship Fund

Chateau Ste. Michelle established a scholarship fund with CSF in 2001 to provide four-year college scholarships to underserved students in Washington State, many of whom are children of agricultural workers who otherwise would not be able to attend college. Chateau Ste. Michelle hosts a signature event to raise funds for the scholarships—a special gathering on the winery grounds in conjunction with their annual summer concert series as well as a VIP reception.

Impact

Our scholarship programs, direct school-based support services, capacity building and advocacy programs are the result of 19 years of collaborations with organizations that share our mission, and believe, as we do, that all kids deserve access to an excellent education.

In the 2017-18 school year, CSF provided scholarships and/or support services to more than 8,000 students in Washington State. Our programs and financial supports are designed to help our scholars achieve at much higher rates than their low-income peers.

- 68% of CSF-WA scholars enroll in a post-secondary institution directly from high school, versus only 52% of low-income high school graduates.
- 61% of CSF scholars who enroll in college graduate, compared to only 47% of low-income students in the state.
- In Washington, more than 9,500 CSF students have achieved a post-secondary degree and more than 2,500 are enrolled in college.
