Communities In Schools of Spokane County impacts more than 9000 students in Spokane County through 16 schools that we have model sites in. With your funding we were able to fill the food pantry at one of our newest schools, Sunset Elementary, as well as provide 25 families with full Holiday meals. Sunset Elementary is in Airway Heights, WA, 75% of the students are considered low-income. It is a high needs school where we provide the students with a lot of supports from basic needs like food, clothing, hygiene supplies and noise cancelling headphones to mental health counseling and tutoring.
