Your support enabled us to collect 88,311 school supply items - a record number of supplies that were provided to over 14,844 students in 37 schools as well as Seattle Public Schools' McKinney-Vento program serving homeless youth. 7708 of those students are in elementary schools, 3297 are in middle schools, and 3839 are in high schools.

We're also proud to share that, over the course of the summer Stuff The Bus events, at first tally, 135 community volunteers gave a total of 412 hours, which is equivalent to one person working full-time for 10.3 weeks.
