Dear Ms. Sheldon,

Thanks to the generosity of the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund, Community Lunch on Capitol Hill has now purchased a new 2014 Ford E250 cargo van to transport essential food and meal supplies from donation centers, restaurants and grocery stores to our meal program sites. This is our 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary year, and our second ever van. The first was a 1995 Chevy cargo van that was becoming increasingly unreliable, so your donation could not have come at a better time.

The total price of the vehicle was \$31,854, including taxes and title. In addition to the [REDACTED] grant from the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund, we received \$25,000 in grant support from the Boeing Employees Community Fund. With these funds, we were able to purchase a van with a maximum payload of 3,500 lbs. The expanded capacity will reduce the number of trips Community Lunch makes in a given week. We also opted to add a rear-view backup camera to help our drivers – some of them volunteers – navigate the compact parking areas of Seattle.

We have included our final receipt, along with mock-ups of signage on the new van. **The total number of people impacted by Community Lunch with the help of Tulalip Tribes Charitable Funds is 4,000.**

In the last five years, we have added two additional suppers to our program. We now serve four days each week, and this growth has required more staff and more donations of food and supplies to provide essential meals to an increasing number of people. We anticipate that we will serve over 50,000 meals in 2015. Now, with a new van, we have the capacity to support these meals – and to look to grow further. **Thank you** for your support of Community Lunch!
