I apologize for the delay on our post-event report for Great Rides Tulalip Drive-In Movie. We have been waiting to receive photos from the event and are still waiting on some of the official photos. But attached are a handful for now!

Thank you so much for sponsoring our Great Rides Tulalip Drive-In Movie on August 12th, 2023. We had a fantastic evening and so far have raised \$27,651! The proceeds from this event will be used to support the mission of the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation, to cure cystic fibrosis and to provide all people with CF the opportunity to lead long, fulfilling lives by funding research and drug development. Just last week, it was announced that the CF Foundation will be investing up to \$9 million in additional funds in Arcturus Therapeutics to test an inhaled messenger RNA therapy that could treat the underlying cause of cystic fibrosis in all people living with this disease. This is an exciting development and couldn't be done without the support of sponsors like the Tulalip Tribes.

During the Great Rides Tulalip Drive-In Movie, the community enjoyed a showing of The Super Mario Bros. movie on a large blow-up screen in the Boom City Parking Lot. We estimate that there were around 150 cars in attendance carrying around 400 attendees. Before the event, we had delicious food options from Kona Ice, Dreamy Drinks, Teepee Creepers, and Sugar + Spoon available for purchase. Kona Ice was even kind enough to donate 10% of their profits to our event. Kelsie Pablo, our event chair, organized a raffle which included close to 100 items including gift cards, toys, and baskets. The raffle was a hit and winners were announced as the sun went down. Folks who donated over \$100 to the event received an official CFF Great Strides t-shirt which included the Tulalip Tribes logo on the back.

We are expecting to get closer to our fundraising goal of \$35,000 before the end of the year through additional fundraising. We are so grateful for the support of the Tulalip Tribes and are looking forward to next year's event!
