Our mission is to provide a welcoming and respectful refuge where all women who are experiencing homelessness, economic insecurity, or trauma have access to a caring community and critical resources.

Our vision is a community where all women have safety, shelter, resources, and the opportunity to thrive.

We build our programs and services on the values of **respect, inclusion, community, and empathy.**



The Women we served

The Elizabeth Gregory Home Day Shelter is accessible to adult women of all ages, racial and ethnic backgrounds, and orientations. **More than 80% of our guests are experiencing homelessness.**

Last year, we served 744 women between the ages of 18 and 84. **Of the women we served, 63% reported having experienced domestic violence, 9% identified as transgender or non-binary, 4% were immigrants or refugees, 4% were veterans, and half were women of color.**

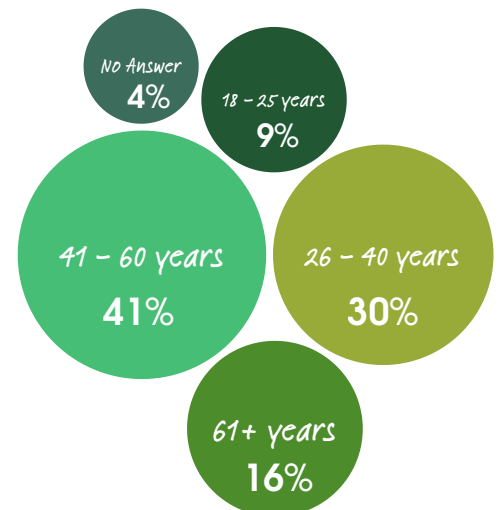

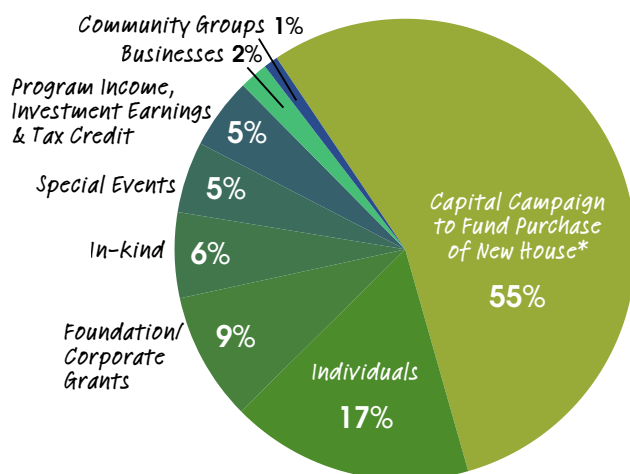

New Transitional House

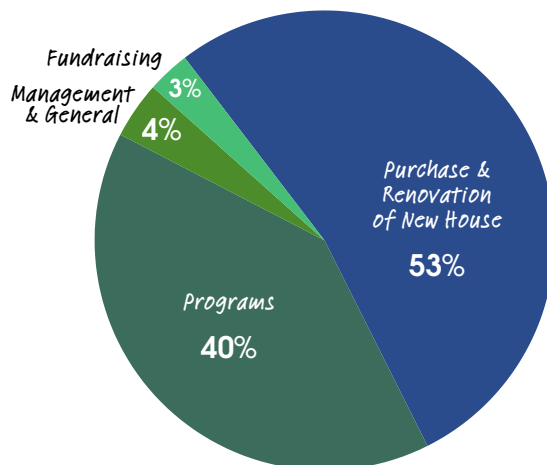
