From everyone here at the Everett Recovery Café, please accept our sincerest thanks for your generous support. As an organization focused on making a local impact, we place a great deal of importance on local support. We are proud to count the Tulalip Tribes among our supporters.

Ever since the onset of the Covid-19 pandemic, we have been striving to continue serving our Members while limiting the chances of spreading the virus. In 2019, we were growing at an amazing pace. December 2019 and January 2020 were our busiest months ever, by far. By March of 2020, we were working mostly remotely which limited our effectiveness and resulted in a sharp drop-off in Membership. A year later, in March of 2021, we moved into our current home and slowly began transitioning away from remote support and back to in-person community. In 2022, it seemed like we were finally picking back up where we left off before the pandemic.

2022 was a year of continual growth in many facets for the Café. We served over 650 Members – 17% more individuals than the previous year – and those Members visited the Café over 10,000 times! We expanded our hours, added more Circles, and increased our staff. A big step was hiring an Executive Director, Brennan Davis, who has helped us grow as an organization and lead community outreach. A big part of our outreach has been engaging with community leaders concerned about the rise in homelessness and addiction and share how the Café helps people escape from the cycle of relapse and reclaim their lives.

Some major highlights from 2022 include:

- building relationships with the Snohomish County Recovery Court and the Diversion Center, making it easier for their clients to connect with long-term recovery support at the Café
- strengthening relationships with the Office of Senator Patty Murray, the Office of Representative Rick Larsen, the City of Everett, Mayor Cassie Franklin, and a number of local Neighborhood Associations
- re-instituting our volunteer program and recruited dozens of new volunteers
- cultivating a host of community partners who make regular visits to the Café to work one-on-one with our Members, including 211, the Snohomish County Legal Clinic, Orion Employment Services, and HopeWorks
