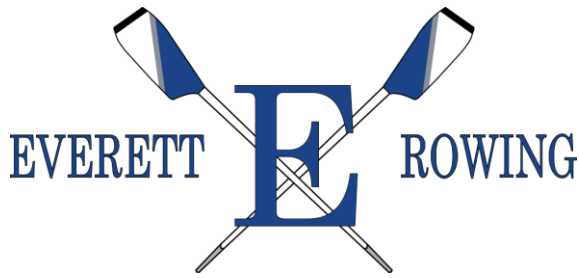

We have completed and installed the Safety Repeater with your funding help. The radio repeater system is used by Everett Rowing to insure communication along the Snohomish River during our workouts and events.

We recently hosted a regatta and our communication was flawless with the help of the repeater. In years past we were unable to communicate from the boathouse to all the areas of the river used by the regatta. We are hosting another regatta October 14th and look forward to having improved communications during this event as well.

Coaches also report that they are able to communicate more effectively with each other during practices. This type of improvement in communications while on the river enhances our safety profile and should provide us with good communications for many years to come.

Per your request, I've included a picture which shows the safety repeater antenna installation. The repeater electronics are inside the boathouse.
