Evergreen Community Orchestra (<https://www.evergreencommunityorchestra.org>) has been very busy since we gratefully received the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions donation (Q4 2021 14.2) last March. Without your support, we would not have achieved two important milestones:

ECO has been selected by Everett Mayor Cassie Franklin to receive a Mayor's Arts Award as "An Organization Making a Difference" for our programming in 2022! The ceremony will be held on Friday, June 23rd at the Everett Performing Arts Center. Social hour at 6:00, ceremony at 7:00. ECO has also been asked to perform at this event. We would love to see you and other Tulalip Tribes representatives there to celebrate this honor with us.

Including the Tulalip Tribes [REDACTED] donation we received at the end of March 2022, ECO was able to finish the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022 with a net revenue of \$864. Besides weekly rehearsals and orchestral arts education for 35+ musicians during 11 of the last 12 months, ECO offered the five free performances listed below.

Total number of recipients: Because two of these performances took place at large public events sponsored by other organizations in the community (The Everett Mall's Trick-or-Treat event and the Wintertide Festival at Carl Gipson Center), it's hard to estimate the total number of recipients / audience members. However, based on reports from Mall management and the Gipson Center, we estimate we provided easily-accessible performances for at least 800 members of our community.

- June 21st, "Musique sans frontieres," Our Savior's Lutheran Church. Everett.

My daughter and I were honored to attend this elegant and special celebration on behalf of the Orchestra. (Unfortunately, we were late to the event because of ECO's successful, but demanding, afternoon performance at the Everett Mall on the same day, October 29th, which went longer than anticipated.) Evergreen Community Orchestra plans to apply for another Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contribution grant by June 1st. We have been proud to display your logo on our website, and in all of our promotional materials, in recognition of your support over the last 12 months. We hope to gain your support again in the coming year -- if for no other reason than to be invited to Raising Hands again this year!
