Project report

Last year the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund generously provided towards the conservation and preservation of a historic mural at the Main Library, 2702 Hoyt Avenue in Everett. The mural is large—7'8" by 28'. The total project cost was almost \$85,000, and took approximately 18 months to complete. The final bill was paid this month, and we want to thank the Tribes for helping to make this happen.

Peter Malarkey, our project conservator, worked steadily cleaning the entire surface, using a special technique to re-adhere the paint to the plaster. He filled holes, and retouched areas missing large amounts of paint. He also made himself available to meet with potential donors to help them understand the nature of his work. The result of Mr. Malarkey's work is beyond what we had thought possible.

We are currently making improvements to the area where the mural is located, removing unnecessary furniture, replacing old light fixtures, and patching and repainting adjacent walls.
