The Request

In Q3 of 2019, we submitted a grant request to help fund our largest project to-date, Twin Creeks Village. This project will provide 24 families (about 100 people) with affordable housing. We were in the planning and permitting stages, and needed funding to help finish the parts of the structural and civil designs that would not be donated by volunteers, as well as funds to help pay for permitting fees.

Project Expenditures

With the provided, we were able to finish the civil engineering plans, the structural plans and a topographical survey. Only minor changes on the civil engineering drawings and the structural plans remain, as well as any changes that will be required by the city after formally submitting the plans. The topographical survey, which consumed the bulk of the Tulalip grant, was central to all of these deliverables.


Results

Because of your gift, we were able to complete plans earlier than expected. These plans were then presented to major gift-in-kind donors. (At just the right time to include them in the civil construction phase!) Three large construction companies have pledged – based on our plans – to donate the stormwater vault (an approximate \$300,000 value), the asphalt paving and fill for the access road (an approximate \$100,000 to \$150,000 value), and installation of all roofing for all six buildings (an approximate \$50,000 value).

All told, these plans, used strategically to court material and services donations from large contractors, has turned into at least \$450,000 of value!


A facsimile of the structural plans and the topographical survey are attached in this report.

Thank you for your generous support. We look forward to continuing our partnership as we work together to bring more affordable housing to our community.





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BUILDING 1 - STREET (FRONT) 3/16" = 1'-0"






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
TWIN CREEKS VILLAGE
