Helping Link/Một Dấu Nối’s October 25, 2025 “Brushstrokes for Belonging” fall fundraiser was a fun and festive celebration of community and culture including commemoration of Helping Link/Một Dấu Nối’s 32nd birthday, special vocal and dance performances by community members, painting and calligraphy activities, and Vietnamese cuisine. We are deeply grateful for the sponsorship of the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions fund, which helped us raise \$65,000 this year. These funds directly support operating expenses at our Renton H.U.B.
