As I write this report, the Tiny House is being picked up and delivered to its new location within Seattle. The Low Income Housing Institute (LIHI) will install the Tiny House within a community where services are available for those in need. There is not a numerical value to place on how many people this will impact as the fluidity of the Tiny House village allows for transitioning to more permanent housing when available.

This project not only taught our students teamwork and construction skills, but also opened the door for in-depth conversations on social justice. Nine students were chosen to participate in the Spring 2019 elective. Although more were interested, the school felt this teacher to student ratio allowed for the most control over the project. Upon completion of the Tiny House the students drew an orca whale on the door to honor the Tulalip Tribes.

I am happy to note that your generous grant will allow for construction of a second Tiny House during the 2019/20 school year. This is because when purchasing materials for the 2018/19 Tiny House project we were offered an amazing deal that afforded us the opportunity to purchase enough to build two homes.
