Thank you again for your grant award of [REDACTED] from the Tulalip Tribes dated May 26, 2023 to support our Nutrition programs.

The landscape continues to be challenging to support our senior neighbors needing help. Even as normal life has returned, community need for nutrition programs for older adults is still increasing. We are serving 36% more meals annually than we were in 2019. Some notable numbers for 2023:

- 35,845 hot meals were served Monday-Friday at the Tulalip Tribal Senior Center
- 2,837 home-delivered meals were distributed on the Tulalip Reservation
- Countywide, the Meals on Wheels program provided 1,715 homebound seniors with 281,578 home-delivered meals.
- Our Community Table Dining program provided 115,000 hot lunches at 11 senior centers.

We appreciate your part in making it possible to meet the needs of low-income older adults in Snohomish County who require assistance to maintain their independence. Homage serves approximately 20,000 annually. In 2023, we also performed 1,222 minor home repairs, provided 25,604 rural rides for medical appointments and errands, and helped 2,678 clients with social services like Mental Health care and Family Caregiver programs.
