This summer ICOPH School submit a request for a grant to be awarded in the amount of \$15,000 toward our efforts to furnish our new STEM lab. The Tulalip Cares Charitable Fund granted [REDACTED] to our new STEM Lab check [REDACTED]. Through our accreditation process, we identified a critical goal that our school needed to enhance existing instructional methodology to connect students to real-life science experiences and careers. We already host our annual science fair as well as yearly presentations from the Pacific Science Center. Additionally, students attend science-based field trips to Padilla Bay Nature Center and Mukilteo beach. We also host an annual STEM day where our students experience the application of science by real scientists from Everett Community College and University of Washington.
