Enrichment opportunities for children are widely known as an equalizer. Over the past 12 months Imagine Children's Museum offered Tulalip children and families multiple enrichment opportunities thanks to generous funding from Tulalip Tribes Charitable Funds. Opportunities included: Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) enrichment at Betty J. Taylor Early Learning Academy, caseworker passes for beda?chelh staff, quarterly Family Nights at the Museum for Betty J. Taylor Early Learning Academy families and quarterly family nights at the Museum for beda?chelh families.

Through the Little Science Lab program 1020 (duplicated) children were served over the 12 month period. Children received high quality, developmentally appropriate instruction that helped develop invaluable skills such as critical thinking and problem solving. The Betty J. Taylor Early Learning Academy and beda?chelh family nights served a combined total of 240 children and their caregivers. At these special nights, families engaged in educator-led activities and also had time to explore the Museum together. The beda?chelh caseworker passes were not utilized to their fullest potential, primarily due to staff turnover in the department. Imagine is working closely with beda?chelh leadership in an effort to ensure that the passes are better utilized over the next 12 months.
