On behalf of the Healing Lodge I would like to thank the Tulalip Tribes, (www.tulalipcares.org) for your generous donation of [REDACTED]. Your commitment to helping the youth in our community is sincerely appreciated; it has allowed us to purchase furniture needed for the new Resident Living Quarters for our youth and impacting over 200 youth every year.

At the writing of this report, the Healing Lodge has received [REDACTED] from the Tribal Charities. These charities include: the Umatilla's Wild Horse Foundation, Port Gamble S'Klallam Tribe, Skokomish Nation, Puyallup Tribe of Indians, Stillaguamish Tribe of Indians, Nisqually Indian Tribe, Suquamish Tribe, Coeur d' Alene Tribe, Squaxin Island Tribe, and Shoalwater Bay Tribe. In order to complete all the orders for all three wings, Pelpalwichiya, Sage & Cedar, a total of \$74,178.49 has been spent. The Healing Lodge was able to provide support to make up the difference.

The Healing Lodge has come a long way in its journey to provide new furniture for the youth being served, but we could not reach our goals without your support. In 2016, the Healing Lodge identified a significant need to procure new furniture for each of the 3 wings, serving up to 15 youth per wing, at one time. The furniture was worn and getting increasingly tougher to repair and safely maintain. The Healing Lodge has now completed purchases and installed the bedroom furniture for all three wings. Additionally, the Female or Pelpalwichiya Wing's TV and Game Room Lounge is complete, the Cedar Male Wing's TV and Game Room Lounge has been remodeled and is only needing to receive the chairs that are currently on order, and remodeling on the third Sage Male Wing Lounge has not yet started.

In researching the bedroom furniture the Healing Lodge looked for a very durable solution that would be comfortable and "warm", not "institutional" in its appearance. In making the final selection, the Healing Lodge selected steel dorm furniture that will endure years of intensive-use by the residents. The higher grade steel construction will deliver maximum strength and institutional durability. The furniture has a high-pressure laminate top surface to give beauty and warmth to the bedrooms of the youth being served. To add to the look and feel of the new furniture, the appropriate linens have also been purchased for the comfort of our youth.

Again, the Healing Lodge is honored and blessed to receive your generous contribution for the betterment of the youth being served at the Healing Lodge of the Seven Nations.
