PROJECT RESULTS: During the recent Kindering Gala & Auction on March 5, 2106, guests were invited to make commitments to financially support Kindering with a donation to the *Gifts of Courage* Program. *Gifts of Courage* ensure that Kindering can continue provide families with support in 2016, many of whom receive services free-of-charge thanks to scholarships.

Thanks to Tulalip Tribes and other members of the Gifts of Courage matching fund pool, we were able to match all gifts at the \$2,500 level. This level is significant because, thanks to the match, each \$2,500 pledge can provide a full-year scholarship for services such as speech therapy, occupational therapy and individualized special education! I am thrilled to report that 17 donors stepped up at the \$2,500 level and, in total, the Gifts of Courage program raised \$267,000, a record breaking total for Kindering!
