Thank you to Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions for the generous donation of [REDACTED] to King County Sexual Assault Resource Center (KCSARC) in 2022. We are honored and grateful for your support and generosity.

KCSARC is at the forefront of creating positive change in our community — change that is only possible because of *you*. Your support allows KCSARC to provide direct services to over 5,000 survivors and their families each year and deliver prevention education to the community.

In 2022, KCSARC served the following numbers of survivors through comprehensive, wrap-around programs:

- 52,357 individuals with sexual violence prevention education, training, and outreach, both in person and online
- 4,636 callers accessed information crisis support, and referrals through our 24-hour resource line
- 370 children, teens, and adults participated in trauma-specific, evidence-based therapy
- 2,431 survivors (of which 1,625 were children) were supported through the complex and challenging legal system
- Parents of 312 children learned how to better facilitate their child's healing
- 531 Spanish-speaking clients accessed culturally relevant therapy, legal advocacy, parent education, and referrals
- 2,376 survivors and their families connected to services
- 2,296 unduplicated middle and high school students received multi-session, age appropriate lessons on boundaries, consent, and healthy relationships

Thank you for your strong partnership and commitment to ending sexual violence. We look forward to continuing to work together to ensure that all survivors throughout King County get the treatment they need and advocacy they deserve.
