Dear Tulalip Tribes:

Thank you for your decision to grant the Lakewood High School Class monies to host a community celebration for the graduating class of 2021. On June 10, approximately 1,000 members of the community took the time to line the sidewalks of the streets between 11th avenue (at LHS), past the Lakewood shopping complex, in front of Twin Lakes park, and over the overpass East to Smokey Point Blvd. At least 60-75 graduates participated and the pace car was the fire engine truck from Marysville Fire Department.

On graduation day, June 11, 75 students came back to the school after the graduation ceremony and had a safe and fun graduation celebration which included game rentals from National Event Pros, (foosball, inflatable axe throwing, inflatable jousting), prize giveaways (dorm room appliances, learning tools including keyboards and two laptops for education, and cash for college) and of course, pizza and walking tacos!

None of this would have been as successful without your partnership. Thank you for helping us see this project through. Five moms worked this entire year by hosting a fundraiser per month, collecting textiles for the Value Village Textile Program, and trying to have as close to a normal year as possible for these students who faced the difficult task of distance learning for 8 of the 9 months of school. Thank you for kicking off their future and making it so much brighter.
