Latino Expo LETI Report

Our Latino Expo took place on July 27th, 2024, with a total of 1,004 attendees. We had over 70 organizations offering resources, information, and health access. We had Seamar, DOH, and Care-a-Van providing 12 total childhood/adult vaccinations, 137 blood glucose checks, and 130 blood pressure checks. Other notable services were free dental screenings by CHC, How to Navigate Health Insurance with CHPW, Molina Healthcare, and options for credit unions with GESA, Seattle Credit Union, and more. We also had small Hispanic businesses selling homemade jewelry, clothing, and candles.

We had cultural performances that celebrated our indigenous and traditional Latino roots. We also enjoyed some delicious food from Hispanic and small-owned businesses that kept everyone coming back for seconds. We were joined by dignitaries, Dr. Amit Singh, Rep. Julio Cortes, Mayor Christine Frizzell, Councilmember Megan Dunn, Former Representative Phyllis Kenney, City Council Member Julieta Altamirano-Crosby, and David Parshall.
