On Saturday, April 25, 2026, Little Bit welcomed approximately 370 Little Bit supporters to The Westin Bellevue to celebrate 50 years of Little Bit’s transformative impact on children and adults with disabilities in our community.

Funds raised at this event support Little Bit programs year-round.
