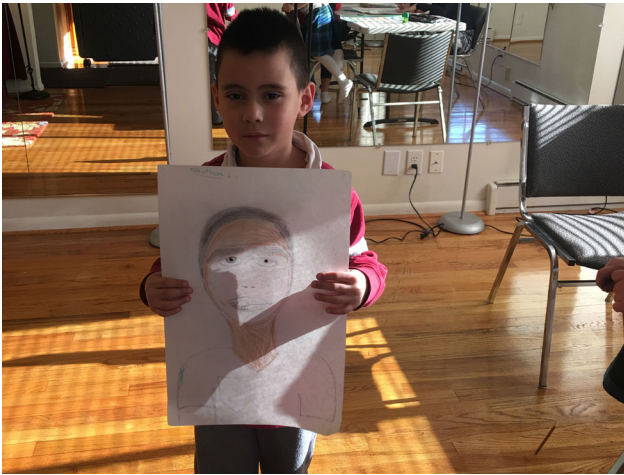

In three months, the following class hours were provided (number of children X number of classes):

Drawing 1 and 2 – 108 class hours

Painting 1 and 2 – 192 class hours

Singing (voice) – 144 class hours

Guitar – 60 class hours

Drums 1 and 2 – 96 class hours

Piano 1, 2, and 3 – 288 class hours

Ballet 1, 2, and 3 – 216 class hours

Hip Hop – 96 class hours

Spanish – 144 class hours

Theater – 156 class hours

Acting 1 and 2 – 312 class hours

Total for three months – 1,812 class hours

684 children participated between January 1 and June 30, 2017 and the ethnic make-up included:

40% Hispanic

6% Asian

10% American Indian

4% African American

30% Caucasian

10% Middle East

We began using a retrospective pre-and post-evaluation to track outcomes in June. For the first six months of 2017, children surveyed demonstrated the following outcomes:

89% increased confidence

74% increased skills

50% increased engagement in community and school

58% improved grades in school
