Dear Marilyn and Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions Fund Members,

I am very excited to report to you that after many months of effort by our hired contractors and dedicated project manager (Ty Wernet, board member and new president of the board) working through component shortages and other challenges created by the pandemic, we have a new freezer and cooler up and running!

Your contribution of funded the conversion of our insulated 40 foot storage container to part freezer and part cooler. This conversion added much needed capacity that will allow us to accept and manage more donations to better serve our community. This has a direct impact on the roughly 6,000 community members we assist each year.

Last week we completed a break-in period of the freezer/cooler and on Saturday we were able to take receipt of four pallets of Farm to Family food boxes into the cooler. This added capacity allowed us to manage twice as many boxes as we would have otherwise. Right from the start the community is benefiting from your generosity.

We still have one component of the funding to complete. We have our plan in place and hardware selected and are now preparing to request approval from the City of Marysville for the installation of a digital sign board to be installed on our building. This will provide important communications to those we serve.

We cannot thank you enough for your invaluable support and partnership in addressing food insecurity in our communities.
