On March 17, 2020 Mighty to Save Ministries, located in Oak Harbor, Washington was the recipient of the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contribution. We received your generous donation just as Covid19 had started to devastate our communities. Due to being unable to put on our annual fundraiser, this donation could not have come at a better time. Because of your generosity we were able to achieve many milestones that may not have been possible without your charitable contribution.

In June of 2020 we celebrated our first anniversary of the opening of Jake's House. Jake's House is a men's house dedicated to changing the lives of those who want to escape a life of addiction, incarceration and homelessness. Through our 1-year, 3-phase program these men learn the tools and life skills to move onto live successful lives outside of addiction. Many challenges arose from 2020, but with the challenges came much success.

Five of our residents completed and graduated our program. Two of these men have chosen to remain at Jake's House and take on the role of in-house leadership, while three have moved out on their own, but continue to stay in touch.



Six of the men obtained driver's licenses and one was able to complete his GED. Most notably, all of our residents are either employed or full time college students.



Through empowerment and education we continue to build leaders at Jake's House. Thank you again for your generosity, without it these accomplishments would not have been possible.
