Dear Marilyn Sheldon and Tulalip Tribal Members,

Last October, Mighty to Save Ministries based in Oak Harbor, WA was blessed with a visit from Marilyn, gifting our organization with a \$■■■■ check to go towards the purchase of the house we had been renting for our Men's Transitional Home, Jake's House.

Jake's House is a one-year, three phase program assisting men as they transition out of a life of addiction.

In our program, these men learn to "live life on life's terms". They learn tools to process through life in a healthy way. Our residents work or attend school as they program, which requires them to attend 12-step meetings and church. They each have a 12-step sponsor or a Christian mentor, someone to help lead them and guide them as they transition.

Each of our residents also meet with our financial advisor volunteer. This person helps each individual with creating a budget, getting out of debt, building a savings and learning how to manage their finances.

Our residents are given the opportunity to heal and rebuild their lives.

By being able to purchase our home, we are working towards the goal of this program being financially self-sustaining with just the program fees each residents pay every month.

Your generous donation helps us reach this goal and we are very grateful to the Tulalip Tribe for their support.

In the last year we graduated three men out of our program. Two have moved out on their own. One was happily married and the other has regained custody of this 2 year old twins. The other remains at Jake's House in a Leadership role, encouraging the other six men currently in the program.

Thank you for believing in our mission as we continue to walk along side these men as they become healthy members of society.
