Moisture Festival relies heavily on fundraising and community support to bring these 200+ worldclass artists together to create the joy and wonder that is the Moisture Festival. Ticket sales provided 47% of the revenues for the festival in 2018. Artists stayed in volunteer homes. 80-90 artists per day got a free hot meal on show days. 20 volunteers provided free transportation to the artists.

Your foundation helped bring the 2018 festival to life, securing the biggest variety arts festivals as an important part of the Pacific Northwest's cultural vitality. The 2018 festival is now complete and we able to pay our bills and *remain in the black* by the end of our fiscal year, June 30<sup>th</sup>. Your funds are much needed and are well spent, leveraged by the generosity of their time by our volunteers and other broad community support.

On opening night, our host acknowledged from the stage that the festival takes place on traditional native lands and that we are grateful to be here.
