We wish to formally thank you for the funds granted to us this past year in the amount of [REDACTED] which helped to cover our annual storage expenses. This amount allowed us to free up other budget lines for production expenses such as set building and decorating, costumes, advertising, printing, and theatre maintenance that all need to be done prior to any income through ticket sales. Due to this ability our sets were incredible, our sound was better than ever, and we increased our sales through marketing and then word of mouth for the high quality of the productions. Between the two productions we count over 1,500 people were involved or attended them, which also benefits Monroe by bringing new people to our town to try our restaurants, buy gasoline, or get a coffee at one of our many drive throughs. Being a part of theatre can be a whole new experience for someone, a safe place to make friends and be creative, or a return to a beloved craft.

In addition to our production quality, the funding allowed us to begin construction on onsite costume and prop storage which, we hope will go toward eliminating at least part of the expensive off-site storage.
