Mount Baker, Scouting America 2025 “Hooked on Scouting” (Fishing) Recruitment Event.
May 3, 2025, Fire Mountain Scout Camp, Mount Vernon/Big lake, Washington.

The day of Hooked On Scouting we had 221 Youth 200 parents/leaders attend the event. 39 of the youth were new to Scouting, the balance we current Scouts. We had a “Recruiter” patch incentive for current you to earn by bring a friend who was not a Scout.

Since the Event on May 3rd, we have one new Cub Scout Pack and Venture Crew formed. In addition, 118 youths have joined Scouting.

Our next recruiting period is September through October. We will be holding another Hook On Scouting type event on October 4th called Cub Adventure Day. Last year we had over 900 total participants, 500 were youth. Almost half of them were new to Scouting.

Your support made the Hooked On Scouting recruiting event possible. We are still dealing with the impact of the pandemic. This year’s 4th, 5th and 6th graders are down in membership because of that. Our 1st, 2nd and 3rd graders are up, making our total attendance flat, so far this year. It will be at least 4 more years as the bubble moves through our system. Based on the current trend Scouting is growing again!

We look forward to working with you to bring Scouting to more families!
