Dear Marilyn,

On behalf of Multi-Service Center (MSC), thank you for your generous support of our work to provide critical financial assistance to families staying at our shelter. Your partnership has enabled us to address needs that would not have been possible through other funding sources.

Your funding through Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions made a significant impact in the following ways:

- Supporting families transitioning from the shelter to permanent housing by covering essential move-in costs, including housing deposits, furniture, and bedding.
- Helping families overcome barriers to securing permanent housing by clearing past landlord debt, which allowed them to become eligible for new rental opportunities and take vital steps toward housing stability.
- Providing arts and crafts materials for children living in the shelter, offering them a creative and therapeutic outlet to express their emotions amidst the challenges of homelessness.

From July 2024 through December 2024, MSC provided 7,358 bed nights for families across 15 units in our family shelter. During this time, we served 67 individuals and 17 households. We do not place time limits on stays the shelter which enables households to move at pace that works for them. However, four families did exit to other housing during this period.

As a token of our gratitude, we initiated a drawing project with some of the children in our shelter. Attached, you'll find a photo of their heartfelt artwork, created to express their appreciation for your support.
