### **NATIVE WOMEN IN NEED (NWIN)**

NWINs purpose as a 501 (C) (3) charitable non-profit Native women’s organization is to support the success of Native American/Alaskan Native Women in pursuit of healing and overall health and wellness. NWIN was awarded a grant from Tulalip Tribes to support the Legacy of Healing and other services under the Family Services umbrella as an alternative cultural healing over the last 12 months. The following reflects a list of activities which began on March 15, 2015 up until February 29, 2016.

1. NWIN transported Native homeless women and families in need of domestic violence emergency assistance and safety to reside at Legacy of Healing shelter.
