Dear Mrs. Sheldon,

Thank you to the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions for your support of the work of Neighbors in Faith. We have had a very productive year in part thanks to your financial support:

- We held 19 Faith Over Fear events all over the state, bringing 1,800 people together to stand up for the civil and human rights of Muslims.
- 2. We held a training for 90 faith leaders to learn how to respond to anti-Muslim assumptions and the \$30 million per year Islamophobia industry.
- 3. We held 20 smaller events and speaking engagements with over 1,100 people attending.
- 4. We taught at 35 churches to create more allies for our Muslim neighbors, and called for repentance in these churches for their past histories of passivity about and participation in the dehumanization of and violence toward those not white and Christian. We are pleased to say that many of these churches are changing their behaviors.
- I was published in the Aspen Institute's "Pluralism In Peril: Challenges to an American Ideal." https://www.aspeninstitute.org/publications/pluralism-perilchallenges-american-ideal/
- 6. I was awarded the Inbound Good Award from the Muslim Association of Puget Sound, the highest award given to a non-Muslim working to bless the Muslim community.
