

# Deck Replacement

We are happy to report that we have completed the deck project for Faith House, our women's entry level recovery house. We are pleased to show you the beautiful results. As you can see in the photos below, the old wooden deck was rotting and had become unsafe for our residents. The sidewalks were crumbling, uneven, and slippery in the winter. It all needed to be replaced!



With your generous gift, we were able to completely replace the deck with composite material that won't rot or need to be replaced. It's safe, beautiful, easy to clean and will last. In addition, we were able to replace the sidewalks; completely tearing out the old and pouring new cement. They are safer, easier to care for, and make the back of the house look more inviting.

It took a team from our community to complete the project. A local company donated composite decking, stretching the budget, which allowed us to expand the project. Our staff, current and past residents, and community volunteers, volunteered countless hours to tear down, replace, haul, and build! In September, we celebrated with a BBQ in our back yard!

Thank you for supporting New Earth Recovery with your generous grant. In 2022, we have housed 55 residents. New Earth Recovery residents live in structured, recovery-based community; heal emotionally; pursue long-forgotten dreams; re-establish relationships with family; develop life-skills; and share their experience, strength, and hope with others. More than safe housing, we provide a program with three structured phases, offering close staff accompaniment and a relapse prevention process called Genesis. Residents meet weekly with a Genesis coach and also participate in Genesis group. Residents explore the roots of addiction and find a safe place to work through past traumas, wounds, and secrets that contributed to addictive patterns. We are grateful for the part you play in bringing beauty, hope, and healing to our community. Much gratitude from New Earth Recovery and the residents of Faith House.
