Number of Individuals Served:

From January 2018 through June 2018 we have fulfilled 225,079 client visits in Pierce County. This represents 43,239 unique individual clients, 1 in 3 of whom are children ages 0-18.

Pounds of Food Distributed:

From January 2018 through June 2018 Nourish Pierce County distributed 3,119,288 million pounds of food to our neighbors in need.

Nutritious Food Purchases:

This funding also allows us flexibility with the cash available in our budget to purchase fresh food when it's needed. Some of the purchases we've made so far for this year include truckloads of: Peanut Butter - 2085 jars (\$30,000), Tomato Sauce and Diced Tomatoes - 816 cases of 24 cans each of diced tomatoes and tomato sauce (\$16,760 per load – 2 loads), Ground Turkey and Ground Chicken approximately 350 cases of 12 - 1pd trays at \$0.99 per pound and Tuna- Chunk Light in Water purchased twice - 240 cases of 48 cans (\$5,978.56 a load).

The cost of a truckload of bulk food is between \$8,000 - \$30,000. The demands for services from our organization seem to be never ending and we certainly could not do what we do without your support. Nourish is dedicated to putting your generous support to the most effective and efficient use possible. Thank you for making this possible!

Often clients reach out to us to let us know how Nourish has impacted their lives. One very young client shared her story:

"Thank you for keeping us fed. If you didn't, I would be somewhere else. I would have moved to some other place. I would have a different teacher, friends...everything would be different. So thank you."
