Thank you for the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund's generous grant of [REDACTED] for social work services at Overlake Medical Center. I'm writing to provide a report on the program's activities in Fiscal Year 2025, from July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2025.

In that timeframe, Overlake created a new program, Transitions of Care (ToC), which incorporates the work of our social workers along with other initiatives aimed at ensuring that each patient is in the right place at the right time.


For example:

- Quickly finding placements for patients who need nursing care after their hospital stay.
- Ensuring that patients in the Emergency Department (ED) who need to be admitted can quickly be moved to a hospital bed.
- Providing ED beds for patients who need immediate treatment, reducing time spent in the waiting room and time spent waiting for a doctor once in a bed.

Thanks to diligent work from our social workers as well as other ToC initiatives, we have seen an increase in post-acute placement rates, a decrease in average length of stay, and decreased wait time in the ED. As always, this work is unbilled and uncompensated. We rely on support from our generous community, and greatly appreciate the contributions of the Tulalip Tribe.
