Dear Tulalip Tribes Council,

We would like to take this opportunity to thank the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions and the Council for the support or our Roots to Wings Program (RTW), undertaken here at the Pacific Northwest University of Health Sciences (PNWU) for the second consecutive year.

For the 2017-2018 school year, RTW convened six times from October to April and served 75 students elementary, middle, and high school students. The curriculum included activities to increase the awareness of RTW students' and PNWU students' culture, challenges, individual aspirations and opened doors for the students to see what no book could show them. Each of the RTW sessions was about 90-minutes to allow participants to engage and participate in a variety of learning activities including lectures, small group discussions, practice sessions in our Simulation Labs, and cultural sessions with traditional knowledge scholars. In addition, the program piloted offering tutoring to RTW students at their respective schools. Depending on the school's needs, tutors offered after school sessions or participated in class to learn along RTW students.

The generosity of the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions made this advancement in education and the continuation of Roots to Wings possible.
