

Page Ahead Children's Literacy Program is the leading provider of children's books and literacy services in Washington State, giving more than 60,000 new books to children in need every year.



Since 1990, Page Ahead has given about 2.7 million new books to more than 850,000 children through collaborations with schools, social service agencies, preschools, and early childhood centers across Washington State. Page Ahead is proud to have received the Washington State *Afterschool Hall of Fame Award* for leadership and innovation in afterschool programs.

Page Ahead's programs

1. **Book Up Summer:** Gives students from low-income families the resources they need to maintain their reading skills during the summer, and return to school in the fall ready to learn.
2. **Story Leaders:** Page Ahead's newest program uses specific early reading techniques to help students actively participate in reading – building confidence, vocabulary, and early reading skills.
3. **Families Read:** Page Ahead offers workshops and resources in English and Spanish for low-income parents to help them support their children's reading efforts.
4. **Story Times:** Trained volunteers bring reading fun and inspiration to preschool and kindergarten age children in the Puget Sound area and Spokane.
