### **Fund Expenditures**

Funding from the Tulalip Tribes provided 71 students from Liberty and Quil Ceda Elementary schools with 852 new books, creating home libraries for summer reading and beyond!

# **Objectives Accomplished**

Thanks to your support, Page Ahead was able to expand our Book Up Summer program to **13,578** students at **76** schools in **21** districts across Washington State during the summer of 2017. In total, Book Up Summer gave **162,936** new books to students from low-income families, allowing them to begin building home libraries to enjoy during the summer months when access to books is crucial.

# **Book up Summer Evaluation**

Data from participating schools' standardized tests shows Book Up Summer reduced the reading achievement gap points by:

- 77% between first and second grade
- 70% between kindergarten and first grade

During the 2016-2017 program year Page Ahead:

- Provided **21,923** children with **190,662** new books through our *Book Up Summer*, *Books for Kids and Story Leaders* programs.
- Delivered services through **176** partner sites.
- Presented 19 Families Read workshops to 240 families.
- Trained volunteers gave **1,640** hours, providing **730** Story Times to **1,286** children.
