Peoria Home is very please to advise that we have completed the renovation of our social enterprise space that will be utilized to provide job skills and experience to women survivors of sex trafficking, prostitution, and addiction who are supported by the Peoria home program.

The grant funds provided by the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund, Rotary Club of Mill Creek, and Zonta Club made this project possible. All new wiring, light fixtures, plumbing, insulation, sheetrock, paint and flooring! Our social enterprise, Born Worthy, will begin making paper products this year, if the current virus situation resolves quickly. We have been forced to postpone training and testing of products until it is safe.

The total number of individuals impacted by Peoria Home since opening our first home February 2018 is approximately 134. This includes the community support provided by our 'Resource Line', residents and affiliates supported by the program, and women in the community participating in our 'Trauma Support Group'.
