Thank you very much to the Tulalip Tribes Charitable Contributions; it is because of your partnership that Rainier Valley Food Bank (RVFB) can provide emergency food and critical resources to thousands of families and individuals in southeast Seattle.

Your contribution of to our general operations in 2017 made for an impactful year for the communities we serve. Last year, 66,771 guests (including repeat guests) visited our facility. Through our food distribution services, we served 16,709 unique individuals and 262,859 duplicated individuals. Our home delivery program provided 7,270 bags of groceries, our to-go service distributed 8,251 ready-to-eat meals, and our backpack program provided 1,809 bags of weekend groceries for low-income students and their families. Overall, RVFB distributed 1,697,252 pounds of food and volunteers contributed 21,381 hours.

Clients also regularly share personal stories and testimonies of how RVFB has made a transformative difference in their lives. A recent client shared:

"I was an addict living under the I-5 bridge, until I rediscovered food. I have multiple health issues that need to be addressed nutritionally. If I didn't have this opportunity at Rainier Valley Food Bank, I would be hungry, pure and simple.
