In the preceding year of Raven Rock Ranch's work with at-risk youth, we had 98% of the youth seeking treatment present with suicidal ideation, along with various other behavioral challenges. At the end of the year, the suicidal ideation for those youth was steady at 2%. ***We did not lose one client to suicide.***

With COVID-19, the Mental Health problems have multiplied in the general population, but in the teen population, the challenges are severely exasperated.

- TEEN SUICIDE IS UP (Source: Psychology Today)
Why? FEAR, ANXIETY, GRIEF AND CHAOS
- CHILD-PARENT CONFLICT IS UP (Source: CPS)
Why? Unhealthy Family dynamics with no reprieve
- TEEN SUBSTANCE ABUSE IS UP (Source: CDC)
Why? No inter-personal interaction with friends

Raven Rock has stepped up our family counselling so that families can co-exist in a healthier way while providing safe- distancing with a few peers while in the outdoor treatment setting.
