Thank you so very much, Tulalip Tribes for your generous contribution of **sectors** to help our at-risk youth. We greatly appreciate it. We help approximately 80-120 people a year at our facility, supplying free of charge over 1200 hours of mental health therapy.

With the kind donation, we were able to add one client. Her therapy will be paid through 9 months of the year. This is life-changing for a young adopted woman of 15 years who is fraught with anxiety, depression and fear. Fitting into school is quite difficult for her and she releases that pressure by exploding at her mom, or retreating to her room in isolation. Her school performance suffers because of the social pressures and uncertainty of constantly wondering whom she can trust?

Because everything we do at Raven Rock is based on trust, Trina (not her real name) has found peace in allowing herself to trust a beautiful, tall Thoroughbred mare named Roomina (Roo for short). Her name is the Roman goddess of motherhood and she takes her name seriously. She cares for the frightened kids who need a loving reassurance from someone who does not need to love them, but who loves them no matter what they look like, no matter how well they do in school or anything at all. Roo stands quietly while Trina grooms her, caring for Roo so sweetly and gently. Trina is learning to be a good leader and take responsibility for another being.

This kind of relationship-building therapy is 98%+ effective because people who need to believe in themselves can begin that journey when a 1200-pound therapist leads the way. Trina has blossomed in the short time she has been coming and I see great things for her in the future, thanks to Tulalip Tribes Charitable Fund, and all of the caring people there who want the next generation to be one of great leadership and courage. It begins one great leader at a time.
